An opportunity to dialogue with Northern Health key health professionals, share traditional knowledge and build relationship!

- **Aboriginal Health - Northern Health is providing an opportunity for First Nations communities to host community events aimed at enhancing relations with Northern Health key health professional!**
- **First Nations communities are eligible to apply for funds to host traditional events, i.e. community dinners with speakers, cultural activities and talking circles to aid in building cross cultural knowledge**
- Communities are eligible to apply for funds to host an event, based on the following: Communities with up to 200 members can apply for up to \$2,000; Communities with up to 500 members can apply for up to \$3,500.; Communities with up to 1,000 or more members can apply for up to \$5,000
- Applications will be processed on first-come, first-served bases until the funds are exhausted.
- Applications will include a description of event; including date, time and location, and NH key health professional attending.
- Upon completion of the event, the applicant agrees to provide a copy of the agenda, brief report on the dialogue, participants views, a record of attendance along with a sign in-sheet and photographs of the event.
