



2010 NRT Certificate, Diploma and/or Trades Bursary Award Guidelines

Interested and eligible BC First Nation students should apply to the NRT Certificate, Diploma and/or Trades Bursary Award. Bursaries are awarded returning students must re-apply for any subsequent years. On first come, first served basis; Bursaries are available starting July 14, 2010.

Number of Bursary Awards Available:

- 60 Certificate, Diploma and/or Trades bursaries @ \$2,000 each

Application Deadline:

No deadline for applications, bursaries awarded on an ongoing basis until funds exhausted.

Fields of Study:

All fields of study are eligible; students must be enrolled fulltime at a recognized post-secondary institution¹.

Eligibility:

Post-Secondary Bursary Awards are available to all British Columbia First Nation students planning on attending an approved post-secondary institution on a full-time basis.

Examples of Ineligible Fields of Study:

1. Conferences / symposiums / workshops
2. Professional Fees / schools
3. Education at non-recognized post-secondary institutions
4. Executive / Management programs

Bursary Application:

A complete application consists of the following elements:

- Application form, fully completed and signed;
- A letter of support from your First Nation or FN Government;
- Proof of citizenship from BC First Nation;
- Acceptance letter at a recognized accredited institution or association;
- Resume/CV

Renewal Criteria:

- All students must re-apply each year;
- Returning students must have a C+ (2.3 GPV) average in order to qualify for subsequent school year.

¹ Government authorities are responsible for post-secondary education in each province and have identified "recognized," "registered" and "licensed" institutions within their jurisdiction.
