Our summer day camp, **FUN Camps**, runs from July 5th to August 27th 2010, in one week increments, monday - Friday 9 am - 4 pm in **Vancouver** (at the UBC Graduate Student Centre) and in **Victoria** (at the Windsor Park Pavilion in Oak Bay).

Each week has a different theme (e.g of themes include: energy, water, transportation, food, nature). Activities include games, outdoors sports, forest walks, painting, making an eco-city out of recycled material, building solar cars, baking brownies in solar ovens, growing sprouts, hiking, swimming, making a tee-shirt and coming up with ideas for social and environmental change projects.

The FUN Camps scholarship program allows our unique summer camp to be equally accessible to everyone. It also enables individuals, foundations and businesses to support young Canadians in attending an innovative environmental leadership program free of charge by sponsoring scholarship recipients.

Scholarships will be granted based on referrals from individuals who work directly with the eligible populations.

**Scholarships will be given out on a first come, first serve basis, so please submit your application as soon as possible.** Successful scholarship recipients will be granted one week of FUN Camps free of charge. We also offer bus tickets to those who do not have any other way to get to camp.
