LE, NONET Bursaries Now Available!

## Bursary Criteria

- Must have Aboriginal Ancestry (proof of ancestry required)
- Must be a Canadian citizen or have permanent residency or be a member of a First Nation band within Canada
- Must be an **undergraduate student** registered in a minimum of **4.5 units** for credit in each term of study for which they have applied for the bursary. Students with a permanent disability are eligible for bursary assistance if registered in at least 3 units for credit in each term of study
- Must be in good academic standing (gpa of 2 or higher)
- May receive funding more than once annually but must reapply on a new application each time and will be assessed based on their financial and academic standing at the time of application
- Must complete the LE, NONET undergraduate bursary application form and meet with the LE, NONET Student Support Coordinator
- Only complete applications will be considered
